Bazaar Russe Menu Glossary

Apple Streudel - thin pastry dough filled with sliced apples and cinnamon.

Blini - crepes with thick blueberry or sweetened cottage cheese filling.

Cabbage Roll - cabbage leaf filled with mixture of ground beef, pork, rice, onion, baked in a seasoned tomato sauce.

Kapusta - stewed cabbage with onion. On Saturday, also includes bits of smoked kielbasa.

**Kasha - steamed whole roasted buckwheat with sautéed onions and mushrooms.

Kielbasa - fresh kielbasa is a seasoned pork served baked. Smoked kielbasa is a fully cooked smoked and seasoned beef and pork sausage.

**Mrs. Messner's Borscht - thick vegetable soup of beets, cabbage, onions, carrots, tomatoes, kohlrabi, etc.

Peroshki - baked yeast-based roll filled with minced beef pot roast, hardboiled egg, sautéed onion and dill.

*Pierogi - noodle-type dough filled with potato and cheddar cheese.

*Potato Pancakes - golden fried batter of fresh grated potatoes with egg and onion.

Russian Rum Cake - white layer cake moistened with rum syrup, iced with coffee frosting, and topped with whipped cream.

Russian Tea - spiced sweet tea.

**Vegetarian Cabbage Roll - cabbage leaf filled with mixture of brown rice, sautéed minced vegetables, beans and herbs.

**Vinaigrette - chilled salad of cooked diced beets, carrots, rutabaga, peas, and potato with vinaigrette dressing.

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All items, except kielbasa are prepared from scratch by volunteers.
