I have not included classes for adults in this schedule. I will send the dates and times, in advance, at a later date and continue to announce every week from the ambo and by email.

The Great Fast is a time to prepare body and soul for the celebration of our Lord's three-day Pascha: the Cross, the Tomb, the Resurrection on the third day. A necessary part of this preparation is repentance through acknowledgment and confession of sins. The services of the first week, in particular, the Great Canon of St. Andrew of Crete offer an excellent foundation for

*Confessions*

Confessions will be heard before every Liturgy of the Presanctified Gifts, before and after every evening service during Lent and by appointment. The number of confessions I can hear before any service is limited. If you make plans to come to confession on a specific evening, please be prepared to stay after the service in case there is a crowd.

As far as children and evening services are concerned, children are welcome at every service. For the later services, feel free to bring what is necessary to keep them comfortable. I do not mind them sleeping. I cannot think of a better place to rest and be refreshed.
