Please note: While I try to adhere to the published schedule, on rare instances due to circumstances beyond my control, a service time or celebration may need to be moved or canceled. I will send an email in advance of any change and try to announce from the ambo on Sunday if possible.

The Great Fast is a time to prepare body and soul for the celebration of our Lord's three-day Pascha: The Cross, the Tomb, the Resurrection on the third day. A necessary part of this preparation is repentance through acknowledgement and confession of sins. The services of the first week, in particular the Great Canon of St. Andrew of Crete, offer an excellent foundation for reflection on the strength of our relationships with God, neighbor, creation, and self as image and likeness. Please do not squander this opportunity. Confessions will be heard before every Liturgy of the Presanctified Gifts, before and after every evening service during Lent and by appointment. The number of confessions I can hear before any service is limited. If you make plans to come to confession on a specific evening, please be prepared to stay after the service in case there is a crowd.

As far as children and evening services are concerned, children are welcome at every service. For the later services, feel free to bring what is necessary to keep them comfortable. I do not mind them sleeping. I cannot think of a better place to rest and be refreshed.
